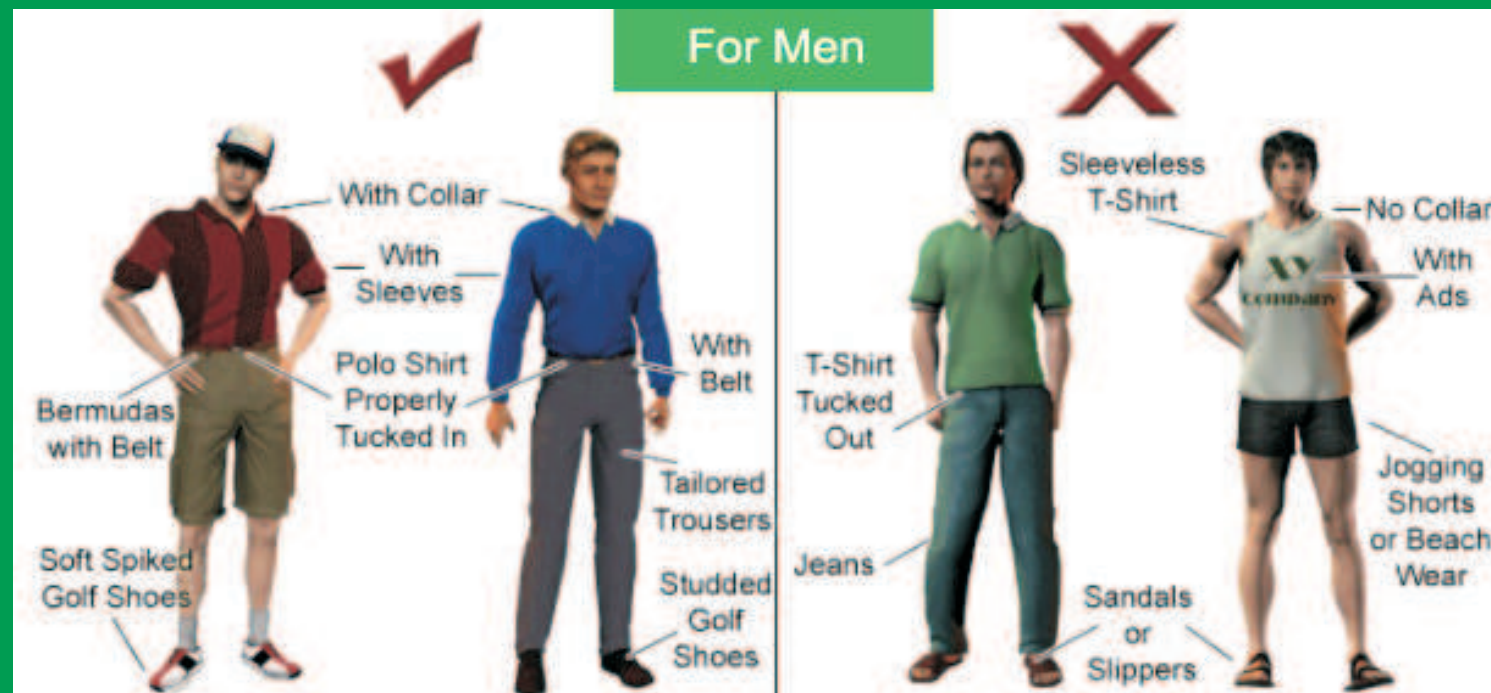


# DRESS CODE GUIDELINES



The DSGR wishes to maintain a reasonable standard of attire on the golf course, practice tee, and in the club house:

## GOLF COURSE / PRACTICE TEE ATTIRE

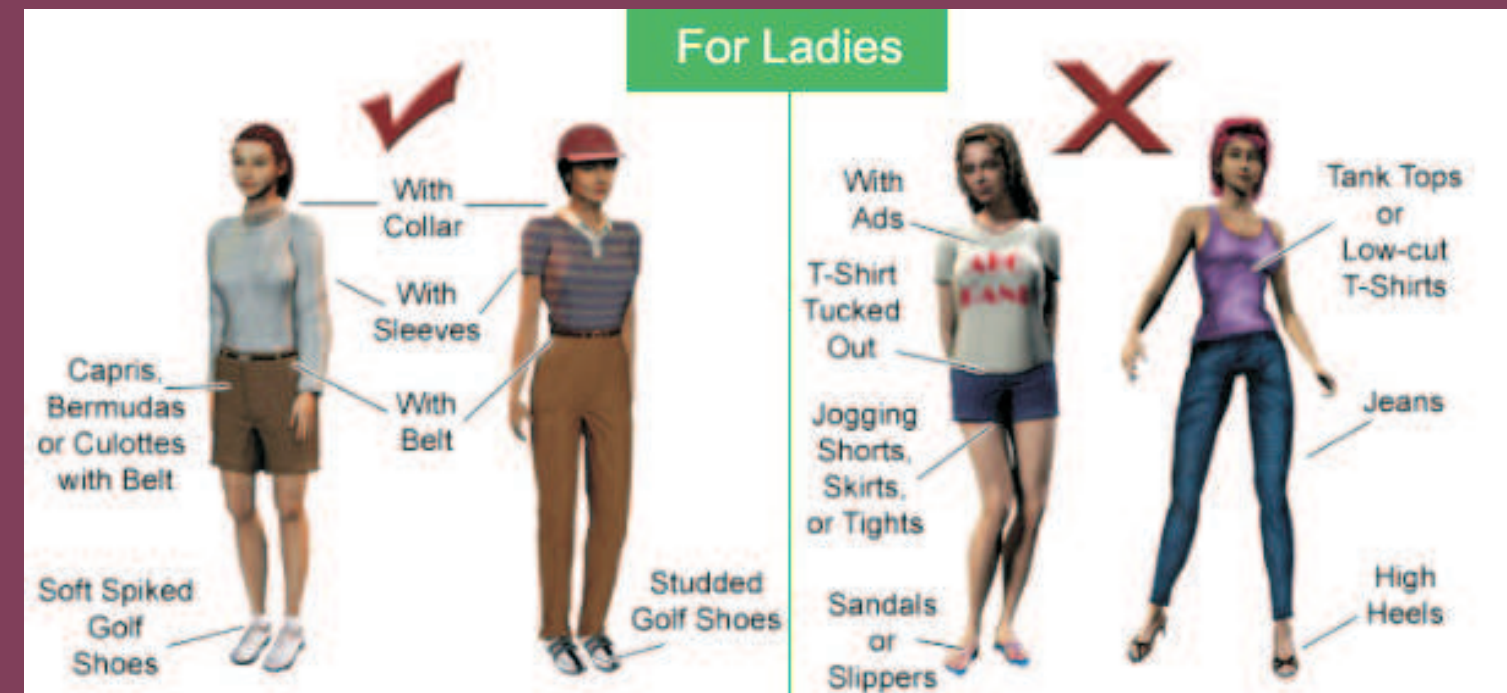
- ① Non denim or Bermuda length shorts, collard shirts, turtle or mock neck shirts are required for men. All shirts and hats are to be worn in the manner they were designed to be worn.
- ② Slacks, skirts, reasonable length shorts, skirts, golf shirt, turtle or mock neck shirts are required for women.
- ③ Jeans, cut offs, sport shorts, short shorts, athletic pants or jerseys, halter or tube tops, tank tops, and t-shirts are not permitted.
- ④ Shoes with metal or ceramic spikes and sandals are not permitted.

## CLUB HOUSE ATTIRE

- ① Clean denim is permitted in the club house.
- ② Athletic wear is permitted in the club house.
- ③ Sandals may be worn in the club house.
- ④ All clothing must remain on during visits to the club.

The dress code does not apply to the locker room area. The dress code applies to all members and guests visiting the club. It is the member's responsibility to advise their guests of the clubs standard of attire.

# DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

## GOLF COURSE / PRACTICE TEE ATTIRE

## CLUB HOUSE ATTIRE

- ① Clean denim is permitted in the club house.
- ② Athletic wear is permitted in the club house.
- ③ Sandals may be worn in the club house.
- ④ All clothing must remain on during visits to the club.

The dress code does not apply to the locker room area. The dress code applies to all members and guests visiting the club. It is the member's responsibility to advise their guests of the clubs standard of attire.
